Joseph Mundell was born between 1765-1784, according to the early census records. He died in Greene Co., Pa., after the 1820 census, presumably prior to 1830 census, but before 1834 when his wife and children migrated to Wayne County, Indiana.

The census reveals the possibility of one daughter and six sons, but we have been able to identify only five. Mr. Leckey in his book, "The Ten Mile Country and its Pioneers", says that Joseph died prior to 1834, at which time his widow, Sarah, his sons, Josephus, John and James, and only daughter, Elizabeth, migrated to Wayne Co., Ind. The other two sons, Garrett and Levi, remained in Greene Co., Pa.

Levi Mundell and family moved to Hamilton Co, Ind. in the early 1850's. Within a few years both Levi and Nancy were dead. In June 1863, Oliver P. Mundell, adm. for the estate of Nancy Mundell, filed his report (Probate Order Book 3:475). Estate was settled on 30 Jul 1864 (Book 3:692). On 7 May 1866, Joseph McCarty was appointed guardian of James H. and Sarah J., minor children of Levi and Nancy Mundell (Book 4:312 and Book 8:248). Several guardians are shown, Joseph McCarty died and John McCarty was appointed (10:227). Still later, Levi Mundell was given guardianship (Book 12).

Based on information contained in two sites about the Boyd family ([www.jesshistorical.org](http://www.jesshistorical.org) & <http://homepages.rootsweb.com/~clanboyd/mdale.htm>), it would appear that Martha Jane Bradbury several of her sons after family names. Boyd, her second son, is her mother's surname; Allison, her youngest son, was her youngest brother's name; and Burns, another son, was the name of yet another brother. Based on this, one can only wonder (for now) if J. Ellsworth stands for James Ellsworth (James being another brother), and Allison B. stands for Allison Bradbury. There is one major inaccuracy, however, in the sit's information. It states that Martha Jane died before reaching womanhood, having died on 30 Sep 1855. This is virtually impossible since the 1900 census shows Josephus and Martha J. Mundell married in Wayne Co, IN.

Abiram Boyd, a native of Wayne County, resigned from the presidency of the First National Bank of Cambridge City to form the Western Wayne Bank. Boyd teamed with his son, James A., and his sons-in-law John K. Smith and Lewis T. Bond to form the new financial institution. They began with a capital stock of \$33,000, which was enough for a privately chartered bank. Within two years the institution could claim assets of \$200,000. The board of directors elected. Smith president after the death of Boyd in 1885. Smith remained in office until 1927. During his tenure the bank grew, a federal charter was accepted and later discarded, and a separate trust company was begun. In 1907 the institution's name changed to the Wayne National Bank of Cambridge City upon the acceptance of a federal charter. In 1911 the bank surrendered its federal charter in order to accept one granted by the state. The move was made in part because of the institution's creation of a separate trust company in 1910. The Indiana law allowed trusts more freedom than did the federal government. The trust company eventually became the financial parent of the bank. A name change, to the Wayne Trust Company, reflected the new reality. The next several decades were stable ones for the trust. Another Abiram Boyd, the son of James A., guided the bank through the Great Depression and World War II. He was replaced in 1954 by his son, Alonzo H. Boyd, Sr., who passed his position to his son, Alonzo Jr., in 1968. Growth accompanied the last years of Alonzo Sr.'s tenure and that of his son's presidency. The bank's name again changed to the Wayne Bank & Trust Company in 1975.

Assets at the bank grew from more than \$3.2 million in 1963 to more than \$46 million in 1993. By the 1980's the bank felt the need to expand. Its first branch was opened in Richmond in 1981. The board approved of the formation of Waytru Bancorp to act as a holding company for the bank and its related activities. In 1991 total assets of the holding company amounted to \$56,589,595, with earnings and surpluses at almost \$3 million.

WAYNE BANK and TRUST CO. has undergone many changes during its 125 years of operation. What has not changed are Wayne Bank's standards of being among the most solvent banks in Indiana, and a desire to provide the very finest personal banking service. In 1882, on the southwest corner of Foote and Main streets in Cambridge City, a privately owned, unincorporated bank known as "WESTERN WAYNE BANK" opened for business. It was founded by Abiram Boyd and James Alonzo Boyd (father and son) and sons-in-law John K. Smith and Lewis T. Bond. Abiram served as the bank's president until his death in 1885, at which time his son James A. Boyd became the bank's president. In 1885 the bank moved to 118 W. Main St. in Cambridge City. This building contained the residence of Abiram and a commercial room on the east side to accommodate the bank. In 1907 "WESTERN WAYNE BANK" became "THE WAYNE NATIONAL BANK" (CHARTER 8871). The purpose of this change was to provide enhanced service and protection for the Bank's depositors. Officers included John K. Smith, President; James A. Boyd, Vice President; Bert Wilson, Vice President. On March 7, 1910 "THE WAYNE TRUST COMPANY" was formed in connection with THE WAYNE NATIONAL BANK. Both institutions were located in the same building at 118 W. Main St. Directors and stockholders of the new financial institution were John K. Smith, President; James A. Boyd, R. P. Lindsay, J. D. Case, R. Battelson, Sandford Wilson, Vice Presidents; Abiram (Bi) Boyd, W. A. Creitz, Robert A. Hicks, secretary-treasurer, and J. C. Dodson. In 1927 John K. Smith passed away and Abiram (Bi) Boyd, a son of James A. Boyd, was named the bank's new president. In 1954 Abiram (Bi) Boyd resigned after serving as President for 27 years sold his interest in the bank to Alonzo Hernly Boyd, Sr., (Grandson of James A. Boyd) who was then elected President. In 1968 A. Hernly Boyd, Sr. relinquished the presidency to his son, Alonzo H. Boyd, Jr. (the 5th generation). In 1975 THE WAYNE TRUST COMPANY changed its name to WAYNE BANK and TRUST CO. In 1981 the first branch was opened in the Gateway Shopping Center in Richmond, Indiana, and remains there today at 4403 E. National Rd. In 1983 a second office WAYTRU PLAZA was opened in Richmond, located at 500 South 'A' Street. In 2007, WAYNE BANK AND TRUST CO. is celebrating its 125th year as a locally owned and operated bank, providing the Eastern Indiana area with personal banking services.
